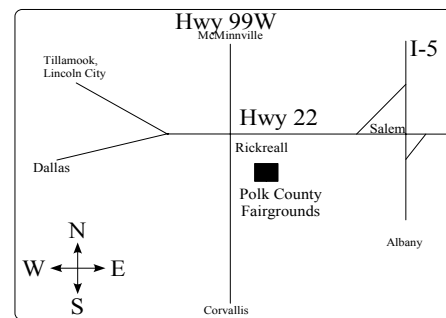


Swap-Tober-Fest

Only two pre-registered participants will be allowed per table during setup. All participants must register, unless under 15 years of age.

- If a purchased table is not occupied, and the organizers not notified, there will be a two year sanction on new tables for that participant.
